5. To approve the Accounts for the Financial year 2022-2023

The Draft Accounts for the year 2022-23 which was circulated was approved by the members. The Draft Accounts was earlier reviewed by the Finance Committee on 12th September 2023.

6. AOB:

- a) The Council discussed the scope of study which was presented by the BCG. However funding for engaging BCG needs to be explored.
 - b) The membership issue of the small tea growers was discussed and it was decided that initially an amount of 3 paise per Kg can be charged from the small tea growers towards membership.
 - c) The Council approved the extension of tenure of the Chairman Scientific Advisory Committee by another year.
 - d) The Council ratified the appointment of new scientists against existing vacancies/ resignations.
 - e) Banking Resolution:

Members discussed on the opening new bank account with Indian Bank, Jorhat Branch, for the new scientific project for the Analytical Services Department and the scheme be called "Studies on the Dissipation and Residue of insecticide "GPI 0621" (Abamectin 4.5% + Bifenazate 43% SC) in Tea, Soil & Water".
